**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

On August 12, 2016, plaintiff Doculynx, Inc. ("Doculynx") filed a Complaint (Filing No. 1) in the District Court of Douglas County alleging claims of breach of contract and unjust enrichment against defendant Macy's Systems and Technology, Inc. ("MST"). The Complaint also requested attorney fees. On March 2, 2017, MST removed the case to this Court and filed its Motion to Dismiss<sup>1</sup> and Motion to Strike<sup>2</sup> (Filing No. 3). Doculynx has failed to file an opposition to the Motion. Doculynx shall have until April 10, 2017, to show cause why its Complaint should not be dismissed.
