- A status conference to discuss whether the parties are interested in ADR or, in the alternative, scheduling of the Pretrial Conference and Trial will be held with the undersigned magistrate judge on November 20, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. by telephone. Counsel shall use the conferencing instructions assigned to this case to participate in the conference.
- The deadline for completing written discovery under Rules 33 through 36 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure is September 28, 2018. Motions to compel Rule 33 through 36 discovery must be filed by October 12, 2018.
