This matter is before the court on its own motion. On September 1, 2017, the clerk of the court sent an order to Plaintiff at his last-known address. (Filing No. 10.) IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiff shall have 20 days from the date of this Memorandum and Order to apprise the court of his current address, in the absence of which this matter will be dismissed without prejudice and without further notice. The clerk of the court is directed to set a pro se case management deadline in this case using the following text: October 10, 2017: deadline for informing court of address.
