**MEMORANDUM
AND ORDER**

On December 8, 2017, after conducting an initial review of the Complaint, the court ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint within 30 days or face dismissal of this action. ([Filing No. 11](#).) On December 12, 2017, Plaintiff filed an interlocutory appeal of the court's order on initial review. ([Filing No. 12](#).)
