
**ORDER TO PROCEED IN FORMA
PAUPERIS**

This case is before the Court on Plaintiff's Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs, [Filing 2](#), in this judicial review of the decision of the Commissioner of Social Security denying the Plaintiff Social Security Disability (SSD) benefits and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for lack of disability. [Filing 1](#). The Court finds that Plaintiff's Application satisfies the requirements of [28 U.S.C. § 1915\(a\)\(1\)](#) and demonstrates that Plaintiff is unable to pay the fees or give security to commence this action.
