1 Pursuant to the Order of the Honorable Lawrence R. Leavitt, United States Magistrate Judge  
2 (Docket No. 314), counsel for Defendants Republic Services, Inc. (“RSI”) and Republic Silver State  
3 Disposal, Inc. (“RSSD”) and Plaintiff U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (“EEOC”)
