**(First Request)**

It is hereby requested by Defendant in this case, IQ-Ludorum PLC (hereinafter referred to as "Defendant") through its respective counsel, that Defendant shall have until July 18, 2006, in which to file a Motion to Dismiss, answer, plead or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's Complaint, with Defendant specially reserving any jurisdictional defenses.

1. This is an action for alleged patent infringement.

2. This is the first request for an extension of time for Defendant to answer, plead or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's Complaint.

3. Plaintiffs filed a Complaint on March 15, 2006.

4. Such an extension is necessary for counsel to confer with Defendant, a foreign company, concerning the allegations of the Complaint.

6. Counsel for Defendant spoke with Plaintiff's counsel who is in agreement with the request for an extension until July 18, 2006 for Defendant to answer, plead or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's Complaint.


7. This request is made in good faith and not for the purpose of delay.


