Currently before the Court is a Motion for Reconsideration (#70) 19 filed by Plaintiffs before they appealed. In light of the Ninth Circuit's opinion (#92), the Court 20 denies, as moot, Plaintiffs' motion for reconsideration. Additionally, pursuant to the Ninth 21 Circuit's opinion, the Court reinstates Plaintiffs' claims against Nathan Albright, Debra Wilcher, 22 23 and Kamer Zucker & Abbott. CONCLUSION 24 For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion for Reconsideration 25 (#70) is DENIED as moot. 26 27 III28 III

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs' claims against Nathan Albright, Debra Wilcher, and Kamer Zucker & Abbott are hereby reinstated.
