**ORDER**

This action is a *pro se* petition for writ of habeas corpus, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, by a Nevada state prisoner. 

In filing an answer, respondents shall comply with Rule 5 of the Rules Governing Proceedings in the United States District Courts under 28 U.S.C. §2254.
