Plaintiff Donna Corbello is the widow and heir of Rex Woodard, who assisted Defendant 13 Thomas Gaetano "Tommy" DeVito in writing his unpublished autobiography (the "Work"). 14 Plaintiff alleges that DeVito and others wrongfully appropriated the Work to develop the 15 screenplay for Jersey Boys, a hit musical based on the band The Four Seasons that has played in 16 the United States, Canada, England, and Australia. The Court has determined that the Work will 17 be entitled to "thin" copyright protection at trial. The Court denied Plaintiff's motion to 18 reconsider. Plaintiff has now asked the Court to certify the order for interlocutory review. 19 Defendants have opposed the motion, arguing that the standards of 28 U.S.C. § 1292(b) have not 20 been satisfied and noting that impending summary judgment motions may moot the issue, in any 21 case. The Court declines to certify the order for interlocutory review. 22 /// 23
