5 disputes and now wish to settle this action, with no admission of liability by any party; and


6 WHEREAS, as part of this settlement, the Parties are entering into a settlement  
7 agreement and agree to entry of a permanent injunction and to orders as set forth herein;

8 NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

9 1. This Court has continuing jurisdiction over the Parties and the subject matter of this  
10 action, including jurisdiction to enforce this permanent injunction, the settlement agreement between  
11 the Parties, and the protective order entered in this action on September 24, 2009.

12 2. WMCV and each of its managers, officers, agents, servants, representatives, affiliates,  
13 and employees, and all persons acting in concert or participating with them, or acting at their  
14 direction or control, will immediately and permanently cease all use of "livinggreen" or "Living  
15 Green" or any mark that creates a likelihood of confusion, mistake or deception with respect to  
16 "livinggreen" as a trademark in connection with any sales, marketing, promotion, advertising,  
17 distribution, and/or manufacture of any services or goods, including but not limited to use as an  
18 adword or similar search term as utilized by any internet search engine or application.
