the Court supports a plausible finding that Defendant Fisher had any personal

involvement in making decisions where Plaintiff McCurdy would be detained or transferred, nor did Defendant Fisher have a decision making role involving Plaintiff's medical treatment. Additionally, there being no allegations or evidentiary basis to conclude that Defendant Fisher knowingly violated a clearly established constitutional or legal right of Plaintiff McCurdy, Defendant Fisher is entitled to qualified immunity with regard to Plaintiff's civil claims. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Defendant Deputy United States Marshal Aaron Fisher's Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative, Enter Summary Judgment (Doc. #68) is **GRANTED**. DATED: October 7, 2010.
