20	of Defendant Maloy Construction, Inc. should be <b>stricken</b> and its default entered based on Defendant's
21	failure to comply with this Court's Order to obtain counsel.
22	<u>ORDER</u>
23	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall mail a copy of this Findings &
24	Recommendation and Order to Defendant Maloy Construction, Inc., c/o Rebecca A. Maloy, at 7820
25	Coors Boulevard SW, Albuquerque, NM 87121.
26	<u>NOTICE</u>
27	Pursuant to Local Rule IB 3-2, any objection to this Finding and Recommendation must be in
28	writing and filed with the Clerk of the Court within ten (10) days. The Supreme Court has held that the

courts of appeal may determine that an appeal has been waived due to the failure to file objections
within the specified time. *Thomas v. Arn*, 474 U.S. 140, 142 (1985). This circuit has also held that (1)
failure to file objections within the specified time and (2) failure to properly address and brief the
objectionable issues waives the right to appeal the District Court's order and/or appeal factual issues
from the order of the District Court. *Martinez v. Ylst,* 951 F.2d 1153, 1157 (9th Cir. 1991); *Britt v. Simi Valley United Sch. Dist.*, 708 F.2d 452, 454 (9th Cir. 1983).
