22 a Nevada corporation d/b/a Nellis Cab Company, (9) Bell Trans a Nevada Corporation d/b/a Bell
23 Trans, (10) Nevada Checker Cab Corporation, (11) Nevada Star Cab Corporation, and (12)
24 Nevada Yellow Cab Corporation.

3. Nothing in this Order shall operate to affect the status of the other Defendants in
this matter.
