18	Before the Court is the parties' joint motion to permit the production	
19	of additional medical and other records for the decedent, Diana J. Reed (#28).	
20	Based upon the representations of the parties, the Court finds that the parties have	
21	a legitimate need for immediate access to the decedent's medical and other records	
22	and medical history for this lawsuit. HIPAA permits the disclosure of protected	
23	health information in certain instances even when a written authorization of the	
24	individual or the personal representative is not available. See 45 C.F.R. § 164.512	
25	("A covered entity may use or disclose protected health information without the	
26	written authorization of the individual in the situations covered by this	
27	section"). One such circumstance is when the disclosure of protected health	
28 ON	information is made for judicial or admin	istrative proceedings. 45 C.F.R. §

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164.512(e). Under this provision, a health care provider may disclose the 1 information "in response to an order of a court." 45 C.F.R. § 164.512(e)(1)(i); see also 2 Crenshaw v. MONY Life Ins. Co., 318 F. Supp. 1015, 1028 (S.D. Cal. 2004) ("During 3 the course of litigation, HIPAA authorizes several options for obtaining medical 4 records from healthcare professionals, including court orders"). 5 For these reasons, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the 6 7 following entities produce their entire medical records file, employment records file and/or financial information file for the decedent Diana J. Reed¹ to either party 8 to this case upon request: 9 1. Ceylon T. Caszatt, M.D. 10 2. Larry Pierce, DDS 11 3. Hilma Illinidala, M.D. 12 4. Lydia Estanislao, M.D. 13 5. Clark County Fire Department 146. Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department 157.
