14	Before the court is Plaintiffs' Motion to Strike Shuffle Master's Revised Construc-
15	tions and References to Abandoned Applications (#69, filed May 18, 2010). The Court also
16	considers Defendant's Opposition (#73) and Plaintiffs' Reply (#74).
17	The motion will be denied. The Court will not attempt to evaluate or elucidate on
18	the case law cited, noting that many (though not all) of the cases cited are unpublished cases, or cite
19	to footnotes in decisions by other district judges. The motion does not justify an elaborate discourse
20	on the law.
21	This Court simply finds that the "changes," which Plaintiffs find offensive, appear to
22	be minor and not more prejudicial to Plaintiffs than the original. Plaintiffs will, and have had,
23	ample opportunity to criticize Defendant's constructions. With respect to references to abandoned
24	applications, it is for the Court to decide their relevance, in the context of a hearing-not in a motion
25	to strike.
