


1 “movant has in good faith conferred or attempted to confer with the person or party failing to make
2 disclosure or discovery in an effort to obtain it without court action.” Further, LR 26-7 requires that the
3 Plaintiff certify that, after personal consultation and sincere effort to do so, the parties have been unable
4 to resolve the matter without the Court’s intervention. In order for the Court to understand the nature
5 of the discovery dispute, LR 26-7 further provides that all motions to compel discovery shall set forth in
6 full text the discovery originally sought and the responses thereto, if any.

7 The Court finds Plaintiff’s motion is premature. The Court therefore denies Plaintiff’s motion
8 and instructs Plaintiff to serve a request for production of documents on Defendants. Accordingly,

9 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiff’s Motion to Compel Compliance with Court Order
10 (#35) is **denied**.
