1 WHEREAS, on December 14, 2010, this Court granted preliminary
2 approval to a settlement of this action;

3 WHEREAS, the Court granted final approval to the settlement on June
4 7, 2011, finding that the settlement is fair, reasonable and adequate within the
5 meaning of Fed. Rul. Civ. Proc. 23 (e) and applicable law; and


6 WHEREAS, the Court has found that the notice sent to class members
7 fairly and adequately informed the Class of the terms of the settlement, was
8 consistent with F.R.C.P. 23 and due process, and was given in the manner
9 prescribed by the Settlement Agreement and the Court's Order preliminarily
10 approving the settlement.

12 This Court hereby enters final Judgment in this case, and dismisses it
13 with prejudice, in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Joint
14 Stipulation (Settlement), Order Granting Preliminary Approval, and the Order
15 Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement (Final Approval Order).

16 Without affecting the finality of this Final Judgment in any way, the
17 Court reserves the exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over this action, the named
18 Plaintiff, the Class, and the Defendant for purposes of supervising the
19 implementation, enforcement, construction, and interpretation of the Settlement,
20 and all orders and judgments entered in connection therewith.
