I. [PROPOSED] ORDER

Pending before this Court is Defendants Rimini Street, Inc. and Seth Ravin (together "Rimini Street" or "Defendants") Administrative Motion to Permit Defendants to File Under Seal Defendants' Opposition to Oracle's Motion for Preservation Order ("Motion"), the Declaration of Robert H. Reckers ("Declaration"), and Exhibit G ("Exhibit") thereto.
