(Mot Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum - #14)

Before the court is the Nevada Highway Patrol’s Motion to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum (Dkt. #14). The motion seeks an order quashing a subpoena served on the Highway Patrol by counsel for Plaintiffs seeking documents which the Highway Patrol claims are confidential pursuant to N.R.S. 480.600.
