Plaintiff has failed to either pay 11 the filing fee or submit an application to proceed in forma pauperis on the required form. See 28 U.S.C. 12 § 1915(a)(1)-(2); Local Rules of Special Proceedings 1-1, 1-2. Accordingly, plaintiff's action is 13 dismissed without prejudice. If plaintiff wishes to pursue this matter, he should file a new action, with 14 a new case number, along with either the \$350 filing fee or a completed application to proceed in forma 15 pauperis on the court-approved form. The application must be accompanied by all required financial 16 documentation, as described in the instructions for use of the form. 17 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this action is DISMISSED without prejudice. 18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk SHALL SEND plaintiff the approved 19 forms for filing a civil rights lawsuits under 42 U.S.C. §1983, an Application to Proceed In Forma 20 Pauperis by a prisoner, as well as the document "Information and Instructions for Filing a Motion to 21 Proceed In Forma Pauperis." 22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall enter judgment accordingly and close 23 this case.
