| 3 | Here, plaintiffs claim that the defendant-lender has failed to provide "a proper valuation of |
| 4 | the property and to identify to plaintiffs the exact amounts due under the Mortgage." (Doc. #1, |
| 5 | compl. at \P 23). However, plaintiffs have not presented evidence that they have or are continuing to |
| 6 | make payments under the terms of the mortgage agreement. Thus, the court finds that the plaintiffs |
| 7 | have not demonstrated a likelihood of success on the merits nor have they demonstrated irreparable |
| 8 | injury as required under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65. |
| 9 | IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that plaintiffs' motion for a |
| 10 | temporary restraining order (doc. #2) be, and the same hereby is, DENIED without prejudice. |
