BENNETT, et al., ORDER 12 Defendant, 13 14 Plaintiff, an inmate proceeding pro se, has submitted a Civil Rights Complaint Pursuant 15 to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (#1-1). Plaintiff also submitted an Application to Proceed In Forma 16 Pauperis (#1). He did not include a properly signed financial certificate as required by 17 28 U.S.C. §1915(a)(2) and Local Rule LSR 1-2. Further, the court finds the proposed complaint 18 is not on a form approved by the court as required by LSR 2-1. 19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file a NEW Application to Proceed 20 in Forma Pauperis, accompanied by a signed and executed financial certificate and a statement 21 of his inmate trust account. The Clerk of the Court shall send Plaintiff a blank application form 22 for incarcerated litigants with instructions. In the alternative, Plaintiff shall make the necessary 23 arrangements to pay the filing fee of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00), accompanied by a 24 copy of this order. 25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff must resubmit the proposed § 1983 complaint 26 on a form approved by the Court pursuant to LSR 20-1. The Clerk shall send the appropriate 27 form to the Plaintiff along with a copy of this order. 28

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall have thirty (30) days from the date on which this order is entered to comply. Failure to comply will result in the dismissal of this action.
