21	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Federal Public Defender shall have thirty (30)	
22	days from the date that this order is entered to undertake direct representation of petitioner or to	
23	indicate to the court her inability to represent petitioner in these proceedings. If the Federal Public	
24	Defender does undertake representation of petitioner, it shall then have sixty (60) days to file an	
25	amended petition for a writ of habeas corpus. If the Federal Public Defender is unable to represent	
26	petitioner, then the court shall appoint alternate counsel.	
27	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk shall add Catherine Cortez Masto,	
28	Attorney General for the State of Nevada, as	counsel for respondents.

1	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk shall electronically serve both the
2	Attorney General of the State of Nevada and the Federal Public Defender a copy of the petition (#1)
3	and a copy of this order.
4	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner's application for leave to proceed in
5	forma pauperis (#3) is GRANTED.
