(Doc. #67). Defendant 16 17 Jean Bennett has not filed an opposition. 18 Reasonable attorney's fees are based on the "lodestar" calculation set forth in *Hensley v*. 19 Eckerhart, 461 U.S. 424, 433 (1983). See Fischer v. SJB.P.D., Inc., 214 F.3d 1115, 1119 (9th Cir. 20 2000). "The party seeking an award of fees should submit evidence supporting the hours worked." 21 Hensley, 461 U.S. at 433. 22 Plaintiff's motion fails to provide evidence supporting the hours worked and the billable rate 23 for the billing attorneys. This court cannot determine if the fees sought are reasonable based on the 24 "lodestar" calculation. Moreover, by failing to provide evidence supporting the hours worked, 25 plaintiff has failed to comply with the requirements of Hensley. See id. 26 27 28 James C. Mahan
