**ORDER**

Presently before the court is defendant United States Department of Homeland Security’s unopposed motion to vacate *Klinge* order and modify stipulated briefing schedule. (Doc. #27).

On April 14, 2011, the court approved a stipulated briefing schedule for this case. (Doc. #14). Plaintiff filed two motions to extend time during the course of the litigation. (Docs. #17 and #19). However, the stipulated briefing schedule was not amended to reflect these extensions of time. Defendant now moves the court to vacate its previous *Klinge* minute order and modify the briefing schedule. (Doc. #27). Defendant reports that plaintiff does not oppose this motion.

The proposed modified briefing schedule includes the following deadlines:

- January 17, 2012: defendant’s opposition to plaintiff’s motion for summary judgment and defendant’s cross-motion for summary judgment
- February 15, 2012: plaintiff’s reply to defendant’s opposition and opposition to defendant’s cross-motion for summary judgment


• March 19, 2012: defendant's reply to plaintiff's opposition
