ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the parties' failure to file a proposed Stipulated Discovery Plan and Scheduling Order. Counsel for Defendant removed this matter to federal court on February 24, 2011. Defendants filed their Answer (#5) March 3, 2011. Pursuant to LR 26-1, the parties were required to meet and/or confer as required by Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(f) within 30 days after the first defendant answered or otherwise appeared, and 14 days thereafter to file a mandatory stipulated discovery plan and scheduling order.
