



1 Second, Saintal must proceed separately with her unrelated equal protection  
2 claims. The Court's October 17 Order describes how her equal protection claims are  
3 sufficiently distinct from the remaining claims in the Supplemental Complaint;  
4 consequently, these claims must be pursued separately in a new action. Saintal should  
5 separately file with the Clerk a new Complaint and, if necessary, an Application to  
6 Proceed In Forma Pauperis.

7 Lastly, the Clerk of the Court shall provide Saintal the proper forms for her to  
8 pursue her separate action.


9 Accordingly, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT Plaintiff's Motion for  
10 Clarification (dkt. no. 61) is GRANTED. The Clerk shall file Plaintiff's Supplemental  
11 Complaint (dkt. no. 50) as her Second Amended Complaint.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall provide Plaintiff the proper  
13 complaint and *in forma pauperis* forms to enable her to file a separate action.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall have fourteen (14) days from  
15 the entry of this order to respond to Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint.

16 IT IS SO ORDERED.
