6	55) Defendant claims that any damages caused to Plaintiff were caused solely by the

9	any, were proximately caused or contributed to by its own negligence which bars or
10	reduces any recovery against Defendant.

12	intervening and/or superseding cause, thus relieving Defendant of any liability.
