The Court scheduled a telephonic hearing on the motion for June 15, 2012. (Doc. No. 38.) On June 13, 2012, Plaintiff filed an emergency motion to continue the hearing due to a medical issue. (Doc. No. 42.) On June 15, 2012, the Court held a telephonic conference with the parties. Cynthia Kappenman Cohen appeared pro se, and S. Scott Greenberg appeared for Defendants.

The Court, pursuant to its discretion under Local Rule 78-2, submits Defendants' motion to dismiss on the parties' papers. The Court will issue a decision on the motion to dismiss without a hearing.
