This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration (#6), filed August 27, 2012.

By way of the motion, Plaintiff requests that the Court order service of his complaint pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c)(3). As a result of the Court's screening order (#4), the complaint in this matter has been dismissed without prejudice. As such, there is no operative complaint in this matter. Plaintiff has until Friday, September 21, 2012, to file an amended complaint that adequately addresses the deficiencies identified by the Court in its screening order.
