ORDER

9 Pending before the Court is the Motion for Leave to File Exhibits, (ECF No. 276), filed
10 by pro se Plaintiff Milton O. Crawford ("Plaintiff").¹ These exhibits pertain to Plaintiff's
11 Motion for Leave to File a Motion for New Trial, (ECF No. 270). The Court denied the request
12 for new trial in its Order on December 23, 2016. (ECF No. 275). Accordingly, IT IS
13 HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File Exhibits, (ECF No. 276), is
14 DENIED as moot.

15 Also pending before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Transcripts on appeal. (ECF No.
16 280). On April 21, 2017, the Ninth Circuit denied Plaintiff's in forma pauperis status and
17 dismissed Plaintiff's appeal as frivolous. (ECF No. 291). Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY
18 ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Transcripts, (ECF No. 280), is DENIED as moot.
