

1	"The filing of a petition for bankruptcy operates as an automatic stay of the commencement
2	or continuation of any action against a bankrupt debtor or against the property of a bankrupt estate."
3	United States v. Dos Cabezas Corp., 995 F.2d 1486, 1491; see also 11 U.S.C. § 362(a). On
4	September 5, 2012, F.A.S.T. Systems filed a notice of bankruptcy in this court. The filing of this
5	notice is sufficient to stay proceedings as to the debtor-defendant. Thus, proceedings against F.A.S.T.
6	Sytems have been stayed since September 5, 2012.
7	Accordingly,
8	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that plaintiffs Trustees of the
9	Electrical Workers Health and Welfare Trust, et al.'s motion to stay proceedings (doc. #19) be, and
10	the same hereby is, DENIED AS MOOT.
