**[PROPOSED] ORDER APPROVING
 SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

16 The Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement in this action made by High Capital
 17 Funding LLC. as Plaintiff and Bill the Butcher, Inc. as Defendant came on for hearing on
 18 2013, before the Honorable Miranda Du of the above Court. Both parties waived notice
 19 requirements for the hearing date.

21 The Court having reviewed the Settlement Agreement dated as of October 3, 2012 and after a
 22 hearing upon the fairness adequacy and reasonableness of the terms and conditions of the
 23 issuance of shares in the common stock in Bill the Butcher, Inc. to Plaintiff in exchange for the
 24 extinguishment of the claims set forth in the Complaint,

25 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 26 1. The Settlement Agreement is approved in its entirety.
 27 2. Within three (3) business days following the date of this Order (the "Order Entry Date"), the

1 Parties shall exchange fully executed copies of the Acknowledgement & Mutual Release and
2 Debt Exchange Agreement, in the forms attached to the Settlement Agreement.

3 3. In accordance with Section 3(a)(10) of the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, the
4 Defendant Bill the Bucher, Inc. shall issue 500,000 shares of its Class A Common Stock to the
5 Plaintiff High Capital Funding, LLC. in exchange for extinguishment of its claims made in the
6 Complaint in accordance with the Settlement Agreement dated as of October 3, 2012 and
7 exhibits thereto.

9 4. For so long as Plaintiff holds any Settlement Shares as defined in the Settlement
10 Agreement, neither Plaintiff nor any of its affiliates will, or will seek to, influence control of Bill
11 The Butcher, Inc. without further order of the Court.
12

13 5. The within Action shall be dismissed with prejudice. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to
14 enforce the terms of this Order by a motion brought by any party hereto.
15

16 IT IS SO ORDERED.
