

14 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion to Strike Defendants' Affirmative
15 Defenses Pursuant to Rule 12(f)(1). (ECF No. 334). Also pending before the Court is the
16 Report and Recommendation (ECF No. 388) of the Honorable Cam Ferenbach, United States
17 Magistrate Judge, entered April 15, 2013. Pursuant to Local Rule IB 3-2(a), objections were
18 due by May 2, 2013. No objections have been filed. In accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)
19 and Local Rule IB 1-4, the Court has reviewed the record in this case and has determined that
20 Magistrate Judge Ferenbach's Recommendation should be **ACCEPTED**.
