Petitioner, 15 who is represented by counsel, moves in proper person for the court to reconsider petitioner's motion 16 to withdraw counsel and for leave to file notice requesting rehearing of Bail Pending Appeal (ECF No. 17 26). This motion is signed and was filed by petitioner's motion Myra Leavitt, "Ex rel Maturna" in 18 addition to being signed by petitioner. Where petitioner is represented by counsel, the court will not 19 entertain motions filed in proper person. Therefore, this motion (ECF No. 26) is **DENIED**. Petitioner 20 is instructed to refrain from further pro se pleadings and to pursue his concerns through counsel. 21 Petitioner, through his court-appointed counsel, also moves the court for an extension of time 22 to file his amended petition. ECF No. 28. The motion is unopposed. Petitioner he further moves the 23 court for an order lifting the stay of these proceedings (ECF No. 29) and for permission to withdraw an 24 erroneously filed document (ECF No. 32). These motions are **GRANTED**.

The clerk shall reopen the action and shall strike the supplemental petition (ECF No. 30) and

exhibits (ECF No. 31) from the record. The amended petition shall be filed no later than October 15,
