19 prejudice;

20 5. All of Plaintiffs’ claims against Defendant Ofc. William Schoen are dismissed
21 with prejudice;

22 6. The LVMPD Defendants agree to bear their own costs and fees;

23 7. Plaintiffs agree to bear their own costs and fees; and
