Having not received confirmation that the United States Marshal completed service on the United States Attorney for the 22 23 District of Nevada, Plaintiff now requests that the Clerk issue a new summons for service along with the complaint. Instead of reissuing summons, the Clerk of Court is instructed to deliver a copy of the 24 25 original summons, complaint, and this order to the United States Marshal for service upon the United 26 States Attorney for the District of Nevada. Accordingly, 27 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion to Serve Party with Summons and 28 Complaint (#15) is granted in part and denied in part. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that The Clerk of Court shall deliver the original summons and
