ORDER

This matter is before the court based on the court’s review of the docket. Plaintiff is proceeding in this action for Social Security disability benefits in forma pauperis but is represented by counsel.

On November 7, 2012, the court entered an Order (Dkt. #2) screening Plaintiff’s Complaint (Dkt. #3) pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 and directing the Clerk of Court to serve the Complaint pursuant to Rule 4(i) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Specifically, the Screening Order directed the Clerk of the Court to issue summons for and serve process upon the Office of General Counsel Region IX for the Social Security Administration in San Francisco, California; and the Attorney General in Washington, D.C.¹ See Order (Dkt. #2). The Clerk issued Summons (Dkt. #4) and mailed them with the Complaint to the Office of General Counsel and the Attorney General by certified mail as directed in the Screening Order. See Certified Mail Receipts (Dkt. #5). The docket reflects that service is complete on the Office of General Counsel. See Certificate of Service (Dkt. #7). No certified mail return receipt has been entered on the docket confirming service on the United States Attorney General.
