Dismissing Case for Failure to Prosecute

This employment-discrimination action arises out of pro-se plaintiff Daniel Kirkland's application to work as a poker dealer at Bally's Hotel and Casino. I issued an order to show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute on September 9, 2014, that required a response from Kirkland by September 30, 2014.² Kirkland was cautioned that, if he failed to timely or adequately respond to this order, his action would be dismissed without further notice.³ He failed to file any response whatsoever. Nor has he otherwise prosecuted this case in any way.
