The parties represent that they are awaiting approval of the 20 settlement from the State Board of Examiners, and upon approval will file the necessary stipulation 21 and proposed order of dismissal. (Id.). The magistrate judge has given the parties until July 22, 22 2014, in which to file the stipulation and proposed order.
