3 Respondents shall raise all potential affirmative defenses in the initial responsive pleading,
4 including lack of exhaustion and procedural default. Successive motions to dismiss will not be
5 entertained. If respondents file and serve an answer, then they shall comply with Rule 5 of the
6 Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases in the United States District Courts, and then petitioner shall
7 have forty-five (45) days from the date on which the answer is served to file a reply.
