Special Order 109(III)(F)(4) for precisely the same reasons, and similarly precludes resolution of the instant Motion for Summary Judgment. Defendants are admonished to abide by Special Order 109 in all particulars going forward. Accordingly, the Court **HEREBY ORDERS** the Clerk to enter the Motions to Strike (#45, attachment #2; #41, attachment #18) as separate motions to strike, including a time for response and reply calculated from the date of entry of the Motions to Strike as separate orders. The parties will have these timeframes in which to respond and reply respectively to these two motions. The Court will return to the motions for summary judgment once the motions to strike have been resolved. DATED this 3rd day of September 2014. Kent J. Dawson United States District Judge
