(Doc. # 61). 16 Plaintiff did not file a reply, and the deadline to reply has now passed. 17 In their response to plaintiff's motion, claimants state that they have no objection to the 18 granting of plaintiff's motion. (Doc. #61). Further, the court finds that the reasoning set forth in 19 plaintiff's motion supports allowing plaintiff to file an amended complaint. Plaintiff attaches a 20 proposed amended complaint to its motion in accordance with Local Rule 15-1(a). (Doc. # 60-1). 21 Accordingly, 22 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that plaintiff United States 23 of America's motion to amend complaint, (doc. # 60), be, and the same hereby is, GRANTED. 24 25 26 27 28
