**Order Granting Extension of Time for  
Plaintiff to Respond to the Individual  
Defendants' Motion to Dismiss  
[#28]**

10 Stephanie Gordon claims she is a hearing-impaired individual who suffered discrimination by  
11 her employer Home Depot and a handful of its supervisory employees and was retaliated against  
12 when she reported that discrimination to the Nevada Equal Rights Commission and the Equal  
13 Employment Opportunity Commission.<sup>1</sup> Various of the defendants filed a motion to dismiss  
14 Gordon's claims, and her response to that motion was due on July 31, 2015.<sup>2</sup> Before that deadline  
15 ran, Gordon moved for a 30-day extension.<sup>3</sup> Although Gordon does not identify what deadline she  
16 seeks to extend, I assume she is referring to her response deadline. I find she has demonstrated good  
17 cause to extend that deadline by 30 days. Accordingly,

18 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Gordon's Motion for a 30-day Extension [**Doc. 28**] is  
19 **GRANTED**. Gordon must file any response to the Individual Defendants' Motion to Dismiss [Doc.  
20 23] by 4 p.m. on August 31, 2015.<sup>4</sup>
