

1 payment of \$32,600.44 for legal fees and expenses billed by Zaccaro
2 Morgan and \$300.00 for legal fees and expenses billed by McDonald
3 Carano during the month of June 2016.

4 The Suzukis did not file any objection to the report and
5 recommendation. The plaintiffs object only to the recommendation
6 that the court allow payment of travel expenses related to the
7 Suzukis' depositions in Japan. The court finds the expenses were
8 reasonable and necessary and therefore denies plaintiffs' objection
9 in this respect.

10 The court also finds and concludes that Damon Key may not pay
11 itself with funds it is holding on the Suzukis' behalf, as those
12 funds are frozen under the court's preliminary injunction order.

13 The court has considered the pleadings and memoranda of the
14 parties and other relevant matters of record and has made a review
15 and determination in accordance with the requirements of 28 U.S.C.
16 § 636 and applicable case law, and good cause appearing, the court
17 hereby **ADOPTS AND ACCEPTS** the report and recommendation of the
18 United States Magistrate Judge (ECF No. 463). Accordingly, the
19 motion for release of funds (ECF No. 447) is **GRANTED IN PART** and
20 **DENIED IN PART**. Junzo and Paul Musashi Suzuki shall be allowed to
21 pay \$32,600.44 to Zaccaro Morgan and \$300.00 to McDonald Carano for
22 legal fees and expenses billed in the month of June 2016.
