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 16 **STIPULATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR UNITED STATES' COMMENT ON PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

17 **(First Request)**

18 Pursuant to LR 6-1, the United States as Interested Party, along with Defendants Nevada  
 19 Power and California Department of Water Resources and Plaintiffs Moapa Band of Paiute Indians  
 20 and Sierra Club, by and through their respective undersigned counsel, hereby stipulate and agree that  
 21 the deadline for the United States to comment on the parties' proposed settlement agreement is  
 22 extended by one week, up through and including September 15, 2015. This is the parties' first request  
 23 that an extension be granted to the United States to comment on the proposed settlement agreement.

24 The United States received the proposed settlement agreement on July 24, 2015, and notified  
 25 the parties that, pursuant to 33 U.S.C. § 1365(c)(3) and 40 C.F.R. 135.5(b), the 45-day period to  
 26 comment on the proposed settlement agreement would end on September 8, 2015. Since sending the

1 notice, the United States has contacted the parties with questions pertaining to the proposed  
2 supplemental environmental project payment. While most of these have been resolved, the parties  
3 need another week to finalize discussion of the remaining issues. Counsel for Defendants and  
4 Plaintiffs and the United States stipulate to an extension of time for the United States to comment on  
5 the proposed settlement agreement and further agree that this extension is supported by good cause.


