The plaintiffs have filed a 45-page motion for new trial. ECF No. 159. That motion exceeds the 24-page limit imposed by Local Rule 7-3(b). The motion also violates Local Rule 7-3(c) because it does not include a table of contents and a table of authorities. Simultaneous with filing the motion for new trial, the plaintiffs filed a motion to exceed the page limit. ECF No. 160. "The court looks with disfavor on motions to exceed page limits, so permission to do so will not be routinely granted. A motion to file a brief that exceeds these page limits will be granted only upon a showing of good cause." LR 7-3(b). The plaintiffs have not shown good cause why their motion must be nearly twice the limit imposed by the local rule. The motion is, therefore, denied.

IT IS ORDERED that the plaintiffs' motion to exceed page limit (ECF No. 160) is **DENIED.** The Plaintiffs' motion for new trial (ECF No. 159) is STRICKEN. The plaintiffs may file a revised motion for new trial within seven days of entry of this Order.
