Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2403(b) and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5.1(b), 18 the Court hereby certifies to the Attorney General for the State of Nevada that the 19 20 constitutionality of Chapter 116 of the Nevada Revised Statutes has been called into question in this action.
