16	September, 18, 2015. But since that time, mail sent to the address provided by Turner has been	
17	returned as undeliverable, ² and Turner has provided no new address.	
18	Accordingly, with good cause appearing and no reason for delay, IT IS HEREBY	
19	ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this case is DISMISSED . All pending motions	
20	are DENIED as moot. The Clerk of Court is instructed to CLOSE THIS CASE .
